RANTHAMBORE NATIONAL PARK

(RAJASTHAN)

Best time to visit: October to June:

BANDHAVGARH NATIONAL PARK

(MADHYA PRADESH)

KANHA NATIONAL PARK

(MADHYA PRADESH)

PENCH TIGER RESERVE

(MAHARASHTRA)

Best time to visit: October to June

TADOBA-ANDHARI TIGER RESERVE

(MAHARASHTRA)

Best time to visit: October to June:

Apart from Tigers, Tadoba boasts an impressive array of wildlife, including **leopards**, **gaurs** (Indian bison), **spotted deer**, **sambar deer**, **nilgai**, **wild boar**, **mongoose**, and **langurs**.

Tadoba is a haven for birdwatchers, with over 200 species of birds recorded in the reserve. Visitors can spot birds like **Crested Serpent Eagles**, **Grey-headed Fish Eagles**, **Indian Pitta**, **Paradise Flycatchers**, **Oriental Honey Buzzards**, and various species of Owls.





JIM CORBETT NATIONAL PARK

(UTTARAKHAND)

Best time to visit: October to June

Established in 1936, Jim Corbett is India's oldest national park and the birthplace of Project Tiger.

Nestled in the foothills of the Himalayas, Corbett offers diverse landscapes, from grasslands to rivers, providing a scenic backdrop for tiger safaris.

In addition to tigers, Jim Corbett is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including **leopards, elephants, sloth bears, otters, crocodiles**, and several species of deer such as **sambar, chital (spotted deer)**, and **barking deer**.
